## Request for Proposal Portable Environmental Beta Attenuation Mass Monitor

#### Section 1 - Background

The Moraga Orinda Fire District (MOFD) requests proposals/bids for the purchase of one (1) Portable Environmental Beta Attenuation Mass Monitor and related components for use by the fire district. Funding for this purchase comes from the 2020 State Homeland Security Grant Program.

#### **Section 2 - Equipment and Specifications**

MOFD seeks to purchase one (1) Portable Environmental Beta Attenuation Mass Monitor. The monitor shall provide accuracy and precision consistent with U.S.-EPA requirements for Class III PM<sub>2.5</sub> and PM<sub>10</sub> measurement. The monitor shall meet the following specifications:

#### Section 3 – Additional Terms and Conditions

Successful bidder must be a factory-authorized distributor and service center to sell the equipment specified within.

#### Warranty:

The monitor shall be covered by a minimum one (1) year warranty providing protection against defects in materials or workmanship.

#### **Pricing:**

The proposal shall denote unit price for each item. Any additional costs shall be listed separately. Proposal price shall include shipping costs and sales tax at 9.75%. Bid prices shall be guaranteed for at 90 days from the bid opening date.

#### **Section 4 – Certifications and Assurances**

Funding for this purchase comes from the 2020 State Homeland Security Grant Program. Bidders must complywith the following requirements. <u>Submission of a bid will represent your company's attestation that it meets</u>, agrees and adheres to the provisions of this section.

- A. <u>Civil Rights Act of 1964 Title VI</u>. Bidders must comply with the requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq.), which provides that no person in the United States will, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.
- B. <u>Debarment and Suspension</u>. Per Executive Order 12549, Debarment and Suspension, and implemented at 44 CFR Part 67, the bidder certifies that it and its principals are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, sentenced to a denial of Federal benefits by a State or Federal court, or voluntarily excluded from covered transactions by any Federal department or agency.
- C. <u>Lobbying</u>. As required by section 1352, Title 31 of the U.S. Code, and implemented at 44 CFR Part 18, the bidder certifies that:
  - a. No Federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid, by or on behalf of the bidder, to any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with the

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- making of any Federal grant, the entering into of any cooperative agreement, and the extension, continuation, renewal, amendment, or modification of any Federal grant or cooperative agreement.
- b. If any other funds than Federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid to any other person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any agency, a member of Congress, an officer or an employee of Congress, or employee of a member of Congress in connection with this Federal Grant or cooperative agreement, the bidder shall complete and submit Stand Form-LLL, "Disclosure of Lobbying Activities," in accordance with its instructions.
- c. The bidder shall require that the language of this certification be included in the award documents for all subawards at all tiers (including subgrants, contracts under grants and cooperative agreements, and subcontracts) and that all subrecipients shall certify and disclose accordingly.

#### **Section 5 - Proposal Requirements**

All costs incurred in the preparation and presentations of this proposal are the vendor's responsibility.

- ☐ Exceptions to specifications: Any exceptions to the specifications above must be outlined in writing on a separate sheet, clearly marked "Exceptions", and included with the bid proposal. Failure to do so will automatically disqualify the bidder.

Postmarking by the due date and time will be returned unopened. Additional time will not be granted to any vendor. Additional time may be granted to all vendors when MOFD determines that circumstances require it.
